Advice: The proposals could not be unqualifiedly recommended for the

following reasons:

1. Because the system is run fully on electricity it will be expensive to run, and the Committee is not convinced that is likely to change in the foreseeable future.

- 2. The cost issue is exacerbated by the fact that it is not a very efficient system. It cannot provide intermittent heating from cold as the heat output of the system is relatively low and it uses radiators rather than blowers so the warm-up time is slow. Overcoming this would rely on maintaining a constant background heat, which is inefficient and costly. Overall the Committee is concerned the system is unlikely to meet the expectations of the community and there is a danger that running costs become an inhibitor to extended use of the building.
- 3. While the Committee does not think the heating units will have a detrimental visual impact on the space, it was concerned that the large quantity of heaters, attached to most walls and a number of pews, will limit how the space might be used or developed in the future.
