Christ-like

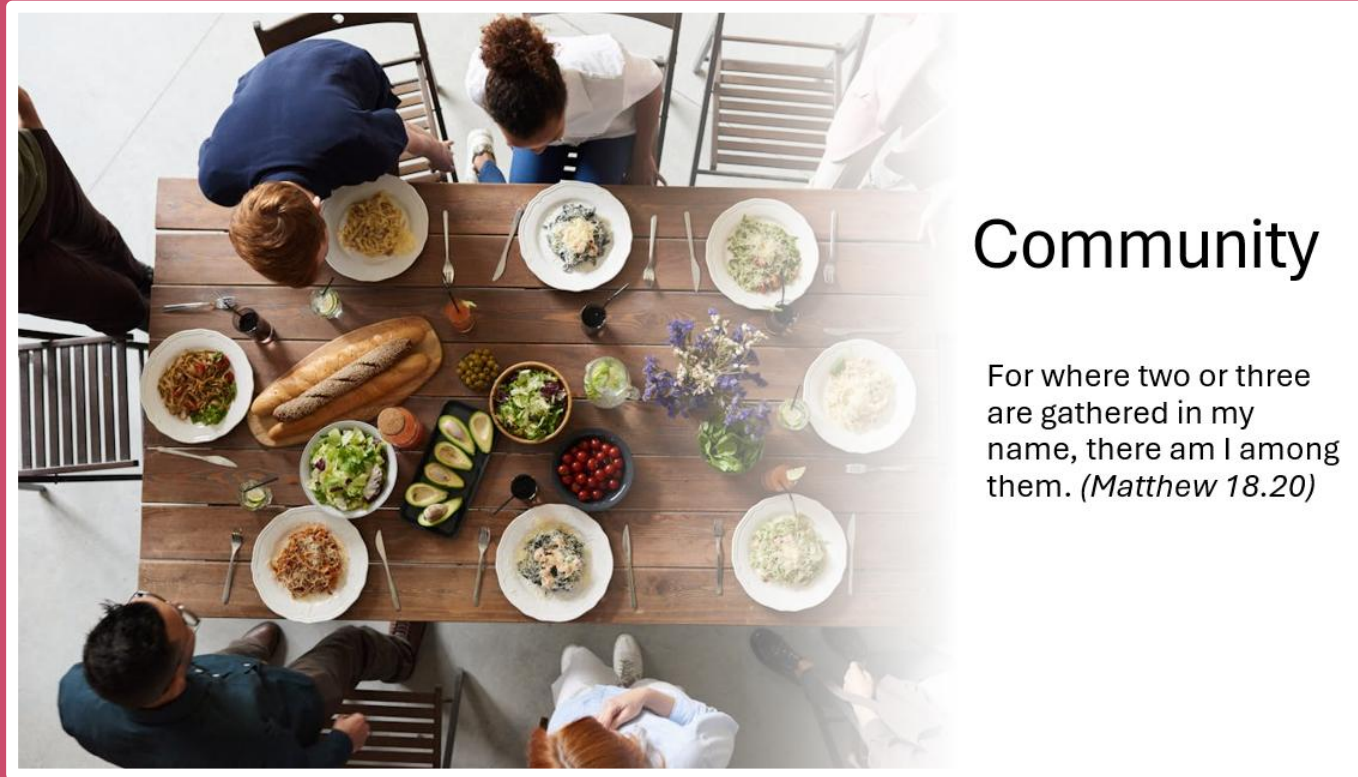


Our first value is Christ-like: Which means to show humility and love for one another, to be welcoming and to have grace and patience

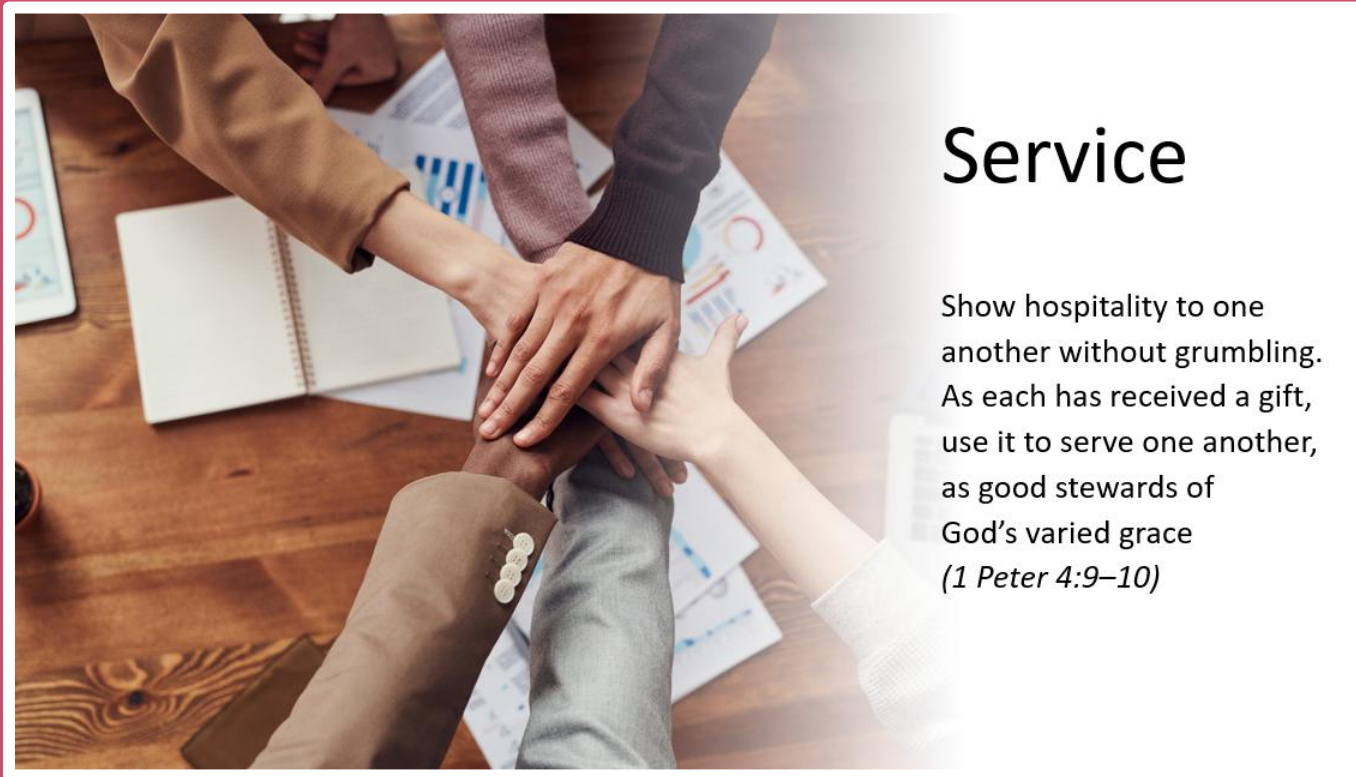


Our 3rd value is Integrity: Which means to be genuine, authentic and honest, and value each other
