Working alongside the incumbent and other local leaders from the rural churches in the deanery. You would be joining a ministry team with a heart to see a thriving Christian presence in all our rural villages.

The shape of this will evolve as the post grows, but it is envisaged that alongside advice, training and support for churches engaging in mission, it will mean hands on working with churches, their incumbents and lay teams, to establish, lead and empower groups in planting new worshipping communities.
