About the Committee

The Finance, Resources & Risk Committee meets at least four times each year to provide financial and risk oversight and expertise, to enable the DBF to effectively support ministry and mission across the Diocese.

Key responsibilities:

- Monitor and evaluate the financial position of the DBF including the long-term financial strategy
- Review and evaluate financial policies and controls
- Assist in reviewing the annual audit plan, scope and financial statements
- Ensure that the requirements of the Investment Policy are implemented
- Review the operational risk register and internal control system

Committee Members

A range of skills, experience and knowledge is needed to enable the Committee to effectively fulfil their responsibilities.

We're looking for three to five lay members and one clergy member with skills and knowledge in the following areas:

- Financial management
- Investment management
- Risk management

Individual members do not need to have experience across all of these areas.

Finance, Resources & Risk Committee members may not be members of Bishop's Council.

Membership will run from June 2025 for a three-year term.
