Appendix B - Overview of the Edgehill Churches and Moreton Morrell

Whilst the primary responsibility for half of this post would be in the Dassett Magna group, the associate minster would also be licensed to these churches in the wider group to aid with the mission enabler part of the role.

The Edgehill Churches (Combroke, Kineton, Radway, Ratley, Warmington and Shotteswell) are a group of six churches that are to the south of the Dassett Magna group.

The churches have a range of churchmanship with some being more formal and others more informal in style.

Whilst none of the churches are large, together they run a wide variety of projects and activities across the area that have over two-hundred volunteers of many different faiths and beliefs. These projects and activities include things like a rural foodbank, a community action

project (called GIFT), a Bereavement Café, a toddler group, an after-school club and many events and activities to bring communities together.
